Dear Lafayette County Goat Exhibitor:

Spring is nearly here, and it is time to get your 2022 market goats purchased! Again, this year, Market Goats will need to purchase a RFID Tag – and weigh in at the fair. The Grand and Reserve Market Goat will be allowed to sell at the 2022 Lafayette County Fair.

Please stop into the fairgrounds and pick up your tags on April 20, 2022 between 10:00am and 4:30pm. Your completed paperwork will be due back to the fairground's office by May 13, 2022. (please deposit into the mailbox by the office door).

Each exhibitor will be responsible to identify their own market goat(s) this year. You will need to stop into the fairgrounds and pick up the tags needed for each market goat (limit 4 tags per exhibitor). **To help cover costs, there will be a \$3.00 per tag cost to each exhibitor. Please make checks payable to: LCLC.** You will be responsible to put the tags in the ears and return the required paperwork to the fair Office by May 14, 2021. If you need to purchase a tagger (at cost), please contact Center Hill Veterinary Clinic.
