

Ambassador & Jr. Ambassador Opportunities:

4-H youth in grades 7-13th (one year post-high school) are eligible to apply to be county ambassadors. Youth in 6th grade are eligible to apply to be a junior ambassador.

What do 4-H Ambassadors do? They promote the 4-H program throughout the county. They assist with 4-H events throughout the year, such as "A Day in the Arts", serve as camp counselors at summer camp, plan Cloverbud programming, and coordinate activities in conjunction with neighboring counties, to name a few.
