

Participation in Wildlife WHEP Wisconsin 4-H & Wisconsin 4-H Forestry activities are open to all enrolled Wisconsin 4-H club members interested in wildlife\and forestry. You can be enrolled in any 4-H project and participate in the activities.

**Overview:** Wildlife WHEP Wisconsin 4-H & Wisconsin 4-H Forestry offers hands-on learning activities, workshops, wildlife/forestry contests, art contests, and community service activities as opportunities of learning for 4-H members and their families. Competition is open to all 4-H youth members in grades 3 through 13. The activities are led by 4-H youth leaders and 4-H adult volunteer leaders.

**Goals:** Our goal is to provide an opportunity for youth to gain valuable forestry and wildlife knowledge, develop life skills, provide new experiences, and career opportunity related information. Other goals are to recruit and train youth/adult 4-H volunteer leaders and encourage family participation in natural science activities. More time outdoors means more fun.

**Resources:** The nationally recognized 4-H Wildlife Habitat Education Program (WHEP) & 4-H Forestry Manuals are used as the basic teaching tools.

### National Dairy Board Scholarship Application

The National Dairy Promotion and Research Board (NDPRB), through Dairy Management Inc.™ (DMI), annually awards up to eleven \$2,500 scholarships to eligible undergraduate students (rising sophomore through senior) enrolled in college/university programs that emphasize dairy. Majors include: communications, public relations, journalism, marketing, business, economics, nutrition, food science, and Ag education. In addition, the NDPRB awards a \$3,500 James H. Loper Jr. Memorial Scholarship to the outstanding scholarship recipient.

## **CENTRALSTAR SCHOLARSHIP**

The cooperative serves dairy and beef producers throughout Wisconsin, Michigan, and Indiana, with DHI-specific customers in surrounding states. The applicant must be presently enrolled in a four-year college or a one- or two -year technical college or short-course program in an agricultural-related field OR be a high school senior admitted into one of the aforementioned programs. *Also, the applicant or their parent(s) must be a stockowner of CentralStar Cooperative*.

Application is due by June 1, 2023. Seven (7) winners will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship. Two of the scholarships are designated for technical-school or short-course students, if two applicants fall in this category and meet the stockowner requirement. Winners will receive notification of their award via e-mail in July or August. Checks are made payable to the university or technical school. If you're a winner, expect the money to pay for your fall semester.
