A newer model within 4-H is the Thriving Model, as you'll see on page 14. The Thriving Model "is a researched-based model predicting that youth who participate in 4-H programs that provide high-quality developmental

context will thrive, and thriving youth achieve key developmental outcomes," as stated by Wisconsin 4-H Division of Extension. At the base of the 4-H Thriving Model Flower is developmental context (4-H Programs) with four areas of focus: Sparks, Belonging, Relationships, and Engagement. In order for a flower to grow and eventually bloom it needs to have a solid start with strong roots, healthy soil, and to be cared for. County-level 4-H programs are the roots and soil for youth to succeed. With a solid start at the local level with nurtured SPARKS, a sense of belonging, developing relationships, and engaged volunteers and youth, youth will grow.

Beyond growing, youth will develop a strong stem, bud, and eventually bloom as the flower model presents, but it all starts with solid soil and strong roots. The volunteers that give of their time and talents to further grow and support the county programs are instrumental. In the end, if youth are not surrounded by volunteers that are rooted in positive youth development to grow the program then their growth will be directly

affected. Think back...where did you or your youth thrive this year? Where would you like to see more thriving opportunities as the 2023-2024 4-H year is quickly approaching?






