In communities across the country, 4-H programming is doing more than just teaching kids how to show livestock or build robots—it's helping young people discover who they are and what they're passionate about. At the heart of this transformation is a powerful concept known as "sparks."

A spark is that special something—an interest, talent, skill, or passion—that lights a fire inside a young person and motivates them to learn, grow, and thrive. It could be anything from photography to animal care, from coding to cooking, from public speaking to social activism. Sparks give youth a sense of direction and purpose, and 4-H is one of the few youth programs designed to help them discover and develop those passions in meaningful ways.

In 4-H, sparks become visible in countless ways. A shy child gains confidence through presenting a project at the county fair. A curious teen finds her calling in veterinary science after working with animals through 4-H. A young leader learns the value of community service by organizing a local food drive.

These are not isolated stories—they're the natural outcome of an environment where youth are encouraged to pursue their interests and are supported by mentors who believe in their potential.

In a world where youth often face pressure to perform, conform, or simply keep up, 4-H offers something different: the freedom to explore, the support to grow, and the opportunity to spark something real.





Show is open to all youth grade 3 through 13 You do not need to be a 4-H member to participate

There is no limit placed on the number of entries per class. Pre-registration is encouraged. Day of registration will be accepted. **Health checks will be performed and rabbits found to be unhealthy will be removed from the show.**

Animals are to be brought in their own cages. Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their own animals. Richland County 4-H Rabbits R Us Club and Richland County Fairgrounds are not responsible for any losses due to fire, theft, or accident. Every precaution will be taken to prevent such occurrences.

Please include the tattoo number on the registration form. If your rabbit is not tattooed, putting a number in the ear with a black marker will be accepted.



2025 Green County 4-H Horse Fun Show

Saturday, May 31, 2025 9:00 AM—3:00 PM

Location: Green County Fairgrounds 2600 10th Street, Monroe

Rain Date: Sunday, June 1, 2025



This event is open to 4-H members and non-4-H members, in 3rd grade thru one year past high school, not to exceed age 19 as of 1/1/2025. All riders ride at their own risk.

A clear, color copy of Coggins for each horse brought, with the Premise ID written on top of where the horse is housed, must to turned in at the event, unless already submitted to the Green County Extension Office in 2025.

Youth under 18 must have a parent or guardian present. Youth and parent MUST agree to and sign the <u>4-H Horse Project Concussion Agreement</u>, in order for the youth to participate.

Entry fee is \$5.00 per class, or a maximum of \$45.00 per person and maximum of \$75.00 per family. Entry fees will be paid at check-in on the day of the event. Checks made payable to: *Green County 4-H Adult Leaders*.

All attendees must also comply with WI 4-H Horse policy (https://go.wisc.edu/3g98if), which includes...

- SEI approved helmets, with harness fastened, must be worn at all times when mounted or driving. Close-toed shoes or boots are required when near a horse. Boots with a cut out heel must be worn when mounted.
- The handler, rider or driver must have control over their horse during 4-H sponsored activities or events.
- No bareback or riding double.
- No horse may be left unattended when out of the stall or trailer.
- Leave at least one horse/pony length between animals.
- When holding a horse in hand, make turns to the right when more than ninety degrees.

Show clothes are NOT expected for this Fun Show.






